At Twydall Infant School we use the method 'Look, cover, write, check' to help children with their spellings.

LOOK

1. Say the word while looking at it.

COVER

2) Close your eyes or cover the word, try to see the word in your head.

WRITE

3) Spell the word.

CHECK

4) Check to see if you have written the word correctly.

If the word is misspelled, all four steps should be repeated before moving on to the next word.

Other ways to practise spellings

- Make the words with magnetic letters.
- Make up special codes/ sayings to help remember words.
- Make word cards and cut them up like a jigsaw.
- Use letter cubes to make words.
- Use the computer.
- Place words on flashcards to memorise the order of the letters.
