Dear Parents and Carers,

We are aware that some parents have expressed concerns regarding the learning in our Year 3/4 bubble. Please be reassured that all children are being taught to make as much progress as they can.

We operate specialised teaching in key stage 2 including year 3 and 4 for Reading, Writing and Maths. The children are split into groups so that the teachers can focus on specific group needs and differentiate work appropriately. We also have specialised teaching for Humanities (Geography/History), Science and Art. Where there are topics re-covered such as The Romans, the children are deepening their knowledge using their historical, geographical and scientific skills, learning new facts and covering different areas of the topic.

The National Curriculum sets out the knowledge and skills that is required to be learnt across years 3 and 4 by the end of year 4. Our teachers are aware of this and ensure that these areas are covered, taking in to account the children's learning during lockdown.

Please bear in mind that for the first week of term we have the Rainbow Curriculum where there is a focus on wellbeing and team building. Children will settle in to formalised learning from 15th March 2020.

All the children will be learning at their own pace and making as much progress as possible.
