Our Learning Overview

All creatures great and small

English

Children will continue to take part in daily phonics lessons and will apply their developing phonics knowledge across their learning. Children will be learning to write a descriptive piece about a foxes habitat, learning which suffixes to add to the end of a word to make it plural. Children will be developing their knowledge on adjectives, giving them a broader vocabulary set.

Maths

Children will be learning about capacity and mass. The children will be comparing and measuring liquids and weighing objects. Children will be learning how to count in 2s, 5s, and 10s, how to add equal groups and how to arrange objects in an array to make counting easier. We will be using a range of resources to solidify learning before moving onto abstract concepts.

Science

In Science, the children will be learning about different animals. We will be looking at the different features of animals and categorising them into groups.

Computing

Children will be learning how to input codes to make an object move.

Geography

Children will be learning about different animals from different continents. We will be looking at animals in Africa and animal in a colder continent. We will be discussing why animals have certain features and how it helps them to survive in different climates.

RE

Children will be learning how stories can have a deeper, hidden meaning. We will be looking at different parables.

Art

Children will be learning about Andy Goldsworthy. We will be collecting natural resources to support our creativity in Art. You are invited in on 21st May at 2:30, to help us with our learning and support in building our sculptures.

PSHE

Children will be learning about relationships in our families and our friends.

PE

In PE, children will be learning how to move in wide, narrow and curled movements on and off the apparatus. In outdoor PE, the children will be developing their racket skills through a variety of physical activities.
